A MOTION authorizing a \$39,710 loan from the Current Expense Fund to the King Conservation District to pay for operating costs of the district for 90 days, while terms for its assessment are being negotiated.

WHEREAS, the county council, pursuant to its authority under RCW 89.08.400, is considering a special assessment proposed by the King Conservation District to fund the district's operations beginning in 1994, and

WHEREAS, without additional resources the district would be forced to cease its current operations before it could receive any new revenue from an assessment, and

WHEREAS, only if the district has its assessment approved will it have the resources to repay a loan from the county, and

WHEREAS, the council wishes to have a signed interlocal agreement between the county and the district that would govern the district's use of the assessment before the council approves such an assessment, and

WHEREAS, through Motion 8887 the council approved a loan of \$45,000 to the district to fund its operations through April 15, 1993, believing that an interlocal agreement between the county and the district might be completed and signed by then, and

WHEREAS, though an interlocal agreement has not yet been signed, sufficient progress has been made toward one and on related issues to lead council to believe it will approve an assessment for the district within 90 days;
