MOTION NO. 9031

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into agreements with the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding the joint funding of comprehensive flood control studies and maintenance of flood control facilities.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature created the Flood Control Assistance Account Program (FCAAP) for joint funding of flood control maintenance projects and related comprehensive flood control management plans pursuant to R.C.W. 86.26 and W.A.C. 173-145, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology is authorized by the above legislation to administer the sum of four million dollars each biennium for flood control management projects and related comprehensive flood control management plans, and

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 86.26 and W.A.C. 173-145 provide that grants will be available to counties, cities, and other public bodies for up to 50 percent of project planning, design and construction costs for maintenance projects, up to 80 percent of emergency projects, and up to 75 percent of comprehensive flood control management plan costs, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology will soon be inviting eligible counties to submit proposals for FCAAP fund grants for the 1993-1995 biennium, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology will only accept applications for funding for a limited period of time that has not yet been

announced, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology will formally offer financial assistance to only the highest priority ranked proposals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The county executive is hereby authorized to develop and submit to the Washington State Department of Ecology proposals for grant eligible maintenance or planning projects.

B. The county executive is hereby authorized to submit FCAAP grant applications on behalf of cities in King County in accordance with FCAAP funding guidelines provided by the Washington State Department of Ecology.
