WHEREAS, additional treatment space for young substance  
abusers is critically needed in King County, and;

WHEREAS, the Bitter Lake facility is currently licensed  
for use as a 44 bed drug treatment facility and has an  
excellent record of operation in this neighborhood, and;


WHEREAS, this facility is currently available for  
acquisition at a price significantly below the cost of  
constructing a facility of this type, and;

WHEREAS, the failure of the county to act expeditiously to  
acquire this facility will negatively impact the ability of  
substance abuse treatment agencies to provide urgently needed  
services to youth throughout the county;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:  
The county executive is hereby directed to seek an option for  
the acquisition of the Bitter Lake Treatment Facility and to  
report to the council on the status of negotiations on or  
before August 1st and at 30 day intervals thereafter until an  
option is secured.
