

MOTION NO. 9057

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to apply for funds in the amount of \$181,443.50 to develop a training course with the Master Builders on environmentally sound development practices.

WHEREAS, King County is interested in protecting the natural environment and the local economy, and

WHEREAS, a training course emphasizing environmentally-sound building techniques developed by the county and the Master Builders Association of King and Snohomish Counties for the construction industry will help ensure environmental protection during construction, and

WHEREAS, an industry self-audit program designed to evaluate the effectiveness of erosion control techniques, clearing and grading practices, and mechanisms for protecting streams, wetlands, and wildlife will create private sector jobs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to apply for approximately \$181,443.50 in federal Clean Water Act 319 funds from the Environmental Protection Agency to develop a training course with the Master Builders on environmentally sound development practices.
