MOTION NO. 9059

A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to submit an application to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for approximately \$10 million in 1993 Shelter Plus Care funds.

WHEREAS, Section 837 of the National Affordable Housing Act amended Title IV of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and authorized the Shelter Plus Care program, and

WHEREAS, the program is designed to link supportive services to rental assistance for homeless persons with disabilities, primarily those who are seriously mentally ill, have chronic problems with alcohol, drugs or both, or have acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) and related disease, and

WHEREAS, King County is the mandated service provider for these populations, and

WHEREAS, homeless persons with disabilities need the rental assistance provided by the Shelter Plus Care program in order for the support services component to be successful, and

WHEREAS, King County is successfully operating this program with funds awarded in 1992;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit an application to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for approximately \$10 million in 1993 Shelter Plus Care funds.
