A MOTION requesting the Executive to conduct a feasibility study to acquire a 16 acre parcel of real estate in Tukwila, WA, in partnership with the City of Tukwila for the purpose of preserving transportation, green belt, and drainage opportunities.

WHEREAS, the County has the responsibility to provide regional leadership and facilitate partnerships with local governments, and

WHEREAS, there is a 16 acre parcel of property located in Tukwila which has a western boundary on Interstate 5 and lies north of South 178th Street, and

WHEREAS, this parcel of property also lies near Bow Lake Park and could potentially provide parking and access to the Park, and

WHEREAS, acquisition of this property by the County and the City of Tukwila could preserve and protect important greenbelt, drainage facilities and rights-of-way on S. 178th Street for an important transportation corridor

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby requested, over the next sixty days, to study the feasibility of acquiring, in partnership with the City of Tukwila, a 16-acre parcel of property in Tukwila owned by Parkway Property, Inc., and to study potential engineering and policy considerations.
