A MOTION requesting the Executive to take steps to implement the employee suggestion program, and making a Council appointment to the employee suggestion evaluation committee.

WHEREAS, the public benefits from efforts to reduce the cost of providing County services and from efforts to tangibly improve the delivery of services to it, and

WHEREAS, employees of King County benefit from the opportunity to creatively address the problems entailed by serving the public effectively, efficiently, and at less cost, and

WHEREAS, ideas to streamline the delivery of services and to reduce costs cannot occur in a vacuum and need official encouragement and recognition, and

WHEREAS, mechanisms to encourage creative thinking designed to create tangible cost reductions and service delivery improvements are not a normal part of a government's operating structure, and

WHEREAS, the best way to solicit suggestions is by way of a structured program which offers recognition for the fruits of creative employee thinking and by offering concrete incentives for their participating, and

WHEREAS, the Council has recognized the need to harness the creative potential of County employees for suggesting tangible savings and improvements by the passage of Ordinance No. 10978, and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to implement the provisions of Ordinance No. 10978;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The Executive is requested to expeditiously instruct each County department to appoint a coordinator who shall receive, evaluate and forward to the employee suggestion evaluation committee such suggestions as may be received, and

3	B. The Executive is further requested to designate a
