A MOTION adopting the 1994 Area Agency on Aging Plan Objectives and establishing a schedule for submission of future plans.

WHEREAS, the Area Agency on Aging was created by interlocal agreement by King County, United Way of Seattle/King County, and Seattle, and

WHEREAS, by October 1, 1993 a four-year aging plan must be submitted as a requirement for local administration of funds from the Federal Older Americans Act, the State Senior Citizens Services Act, Title XIX (Medicaid), U.S. Department of Agriculture, State Respite Care, and State Adult Day Health, and

WHEREAS, a 1993 budget proviso requested the executive to propose a means by which the council can participate in the plan approval process to help improve the linkages with other related planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, executive staff made a presentation to the King County fiscal management and human services committee on the Area Agency on Aging Plan to be submitted to the Washington State Aging and Adult Services Administration, and

WHEREAS, the committee gave direction that the council would annually review the objectives of the Plan, and

WHEREAS, the executive has submitted for council review draft 1994 planning objectives as approved by the Area Agency on Aging sponsors (representatives from King County, Seattle, and United Way) on July, 29th, 1993, and

WHEREAS, the draft document will be available for public comment from September 1 to 17 with final plan approval by the Area Agency on Aging scheduled for September 23, 1993;
