A MOTION authorizing the acceptance of a gift, the sum of five hundred dollars, from the Keep Washington Green Association for the purchase of replacement vegetation along portions of the Burke-Gilman Trail.

WHEREAS, King County recognizes that trails, natural areas and greenbelts are important to the quality of life for all citizens of King County, and

WHEREAS, King County maintains the Burke-Gilman Trail from N.E. 145th Street to Juanita Drive N.E., and

WHEREAS, the Parks Division has determined that it is advisable to replace existing damaged vegetation with healthy, native species where appropriate, and


WHEREAS, King County has the support of most property owners along the Burke-Gilman Trail between N.E. 165th and 16202 Beach Drive N.E. to develop and administer a pilot project to replace severely pruned and damaged vegetation along the trail,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The King County Executive, on behalf of the citizens of King County, is hereby authorized to accept this gift from the Keep Washington Green Association. The gift will be used for the purchase of appropriate plant material to revegetate the above designated portion of the Burke-Gilman Trail.
