## MOTION NO. 9141

A MOTION authorizing the Executive to negotiate and execute an agreement with the City of Seattle that will provide up to \$50,000 from the Stadium Operating Fund to pay for a share of the cost of a comprehensive downtown traffic study that will be performed under Seattle's direction.

WHEREAS, the vital economic interests of a community depend upon an effective transportation and parking pattern, and

WHEREAS, Kingdome tenants and patrons are significantly affected by traffic congestion in the south downtown area caused in part by the south ferry access and the completion of the I-90 off-ramp, and

WHEREAS, the presence of the Kingdome contributes to traffic congestion in the south downtown area of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, King County supports the use of mass transit as a means to relieve traffic congestion, and

WHEREAS, King County has been asked by the city of Seattle to participate in a comprehensive traffic study of the south downtown area including the Kingdome, in connection with the city of Seattle, phase two of the multi-modal terminal study, and

WHEREAS, this study will result in a commitment to action by participating agencies, and

WHEREAS, this need has been demonstrated in various studies including the Kingdome Master Plan and the Port of Seattle Container Access Study, and

WHEREAS, this study will bring together all major entities that affect and are affected by traffic in the area, including the Port, the city of Seattle, the state, METRO, King County and principal private sector entities;
