A MOTION relating to implementation of the Management Audit of Police Overtime for Court Appearances.

WHEREAS, the management audit of police overtime for court appearances was presented to and accepted by the council committee-of-the-whole on October 15, 1993, and

WHEREAS, the audit found that over 80% of court appearances by King County police officers in January and February 1993, and related overtime costs, occurred in King County district court, and

WHEREAS, the audit recommended implementation of a "key system" to schedule officers' appearances in district court for specific dates, thereby controlling police court overtime expenditures, and

WHEREAS, the audit also recommended that, in conjunction with the "key system," county officers be assigned to write citations to individual divisions of district court in order to facilitate implementation of the "key system" and provide for caseload management in district court, and

WHEREAS, the responses to the audit from the district court, the executive and the department of public safety indicated general concurrence with the audit findings and recommendations, and indicated their intent to implement the "key system" in district court by January 1, 1994;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The "key system" shall be used for scheduling court dates for non-jury trials no later than January 1, 1994.
- B. The district court, the department of public safety and the office of the prosecuting attorney shall continue to coordinate implementation of the "key system" and shall monitor adherence to the system by all parties.
- C. The district court and the department of public safety shall provide to the council, no later than April 30, 1994, a
