WHEREAS, the King County council Motion 8987 requested that the county executive prepare a Transportation Demand Management (TDM) report containing "recommendations to the council for a work program to develop and recommend a comprehensive set of transportation demand management policies, performance measures and priorities, a monitoring system and a collaborative intergovernmental process to reduce congestion and to achieve a measurable reduction in vehicle miles traveled and single occupant vehicle trips" and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes the importance of managing this area's transportation system to protect the quality of life and economic vitality of the region, and

WHEREAS, the TDM work program will consider and recommend actions to measurably improve mobility by making more efficient use of existing and future local transportation systems, and

WHEREAS, the TDM work program will result in actions to reduce per capita motor vehicle trips and vehicle miles traveled in order to decrease fuel and energy consumption and lessen automobile-generated air, noise, and water pollution associated with the use of single occupant vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the TDM work program supports the policies of VISION 2020, the Growth Management Act, the Countywide Planning Policies, the county's Commute Trip Reduction ordinance, the county's 1985 Comprehensive Plan, and the county's Transportation Plan (and Arterial/High Occupancy Vehicle and Nonmotorized Plan elements), that facilitate and encourage the use of transit, high occupancy vehicles (HOVs), and nonmotorized uses, and


WHEREAS, the county's TDM actions will enhance and complement the State Commute Trip Reduction law adopted as part of the Clean Air Washington Act;
