A MOTION requesting the Executive to forward to the Council an appropriation ordinance for funding a feasibility study for recommending to the State Legislature the adoption of uniform misdemeanor sentencing guidelines for municipal and district courts in King County.

MOTION NO.

WHEREAS, an underlying purpose of the criminal justice system is insuring that justice is apportioned fairly and equally to all persons convicted of committing crimes; and

WHEREAS, King County has a strong interest in insuring that all persons convicted of offenses that are similar or the same receive sentences that are generally similar or are within a determined range; and

WHEREAS, the administration of justice is made unduly complex by disparities in the sentences meted out by courts of limited jurisdiction to misdemeanants; and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington has recognized the validity of the principle of convicted persons receiving sentences within determined standard ranges for their specific offenses through the adoption of sentencing guidelines in the superior courts; and

WHEREAS, the lack of sentencing guidelines to be used by courts of limited jurisdiction may result in justice being dispensed unequally; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of all affected King County criminal justice agencies and the general public to have a clearer understanding of the nature, philosophy and implications of present sentencing philosophy; and

WHEREAS, a study of the issue is expected to benefit the King County criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the need to examine and further understand this issue requires the dedication of adequate resources to that effort;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is requested to forward to the 1 Council no later than January 31, 1994 an appropriations 2 3 ordinance for at least one temporary full-time equivalent whose purpose shall be the compilation and analysis of existing 4 information throughout all King County jurisdictions on the 5 6 nature of sentencing of misdemeanants in courts of limited 7 jurisdiction. The purpose of this analysis shall be an 8 understanding of disparities in the present system of sentencing misdemeanants and a recommendation on the nature of 9 10 reforms to be proposed to the State of Washington.
