1 MOTION #94-29, INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER PULLEN
2 JOINT RESOLUTION NO. JR94-2, SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER STONER

3 A JOINT MOTION AND RESOLUTION OF THE METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL
4 AND THE PIERCE COUNTY COUNCIL APPOINTING LES THOMAS TO
5 REPRESENT LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT NO. 31 IN THE WASHINGTON STATE HOUSE
6 OF REPRESENTATIVES.

7 WHEREAS, a vacancy has been created in the 31st Legislative
8 District, Washington State House of Representatives, because of the
9 resignation of Representative Christopher Vance; and

10 WHEREAS, Legislative District No. 31 is a multi-jurisdictional
11 District located partly in King County and partly in Pierce County,
12 and the Washington State Constitution, Article II, Section 15,
13 provides that in the event of a multi-jurisdictional vacancy, that
14 the vacancy shall be filled by joint action of the Boards; and

15 WHEREAS, the Washington State Republican Central Committee has
16 submitted the names of three nominees for the vacancy in the House of
17 Representatives for consideration by the Metropolitan King County
18 Council and the Pierce County Council, and the two Councils have met
19 in a joint special meeting and have interviewed the nominees; NOW
20 THEREFORE,

21 BE IT MOVED AND RESOLVED BY THE METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL
22 AND THE PIERCE COUNTY COUNCIL:

23 Section 1. Les Thomas is one of the three nominees
24 recommended by the Washington State Republican Central Committee, and
25 is qualified to fill the vacancy in the House of Representatives.

26 Section 2. Les Thomas is hereby appointed to the Washington
27 State House of Representatives, Legislative District No. 31, to fill
28 the vacancy left by the resignation of Representative Christopher
Vance.
