

MOTION NO. **9223**

A MOTION authorizing the executive to submit an application for Washington State Transportation Improvement Account (TIA) grant funds for a road capital improvement project in the Kingsgate area known as 124th Avenue Northeast.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) has issued an invitation for grant applications, with a deadline of January 31, 1994, and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Account (TIA) grant selection criteria favor urban area improvements with multi-modal and/or multi-agency characteristics, and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Needs Report (TNR) identifies as a high priority project (TNR Score = 527) a minor widening of 124th Avenue Northeast, from Northeast 132nd to Northeast 169th, which is the main north-south arterial in the Kingsgate area, and

WHEREAS, the area to be improved is partly in the unincorporated area and partly in the city of Woodinville, and the city has expressed its support for King County to act as lead in a TIA grant submittal, and

WHEREAS, the Woodinville city council, on January 10, 1994, passed a motion in support of the grant application for preliminary engineering work and has committed up to \$95,800 for the city's share of the local match required by the grant, and

WHEREAS, the 124th Avenue Northeast project was not included in the recently adopted 1994-99 Roads Capital Improvement Program (CIP), due to the lack of available funds, and

WHEREAS, King County's share of the required local match for preliminary engineering, estimated at \$140,000, would be available from the Road Construction Fund balance, in the event the grant is awarded by the TIB;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

1. The executive is authorized to submit to the TIB a TIA grant application for preliminary engineering on 124th Avenue Northeast, with the local match to be shared jointly by King County and the city of Woodinville.

2. King County's share of the local match is available from the Roads Construction Fund (386) fund balance.

3. In the event the TIB awards the grant, the executive shall submit to the county council an amendment to the 1994-99, roads' CIP to include the funded portion of the project.
