WHEREAS, properties located in the east half of section 32 township 24 range 4 were classified Heavy Manufacturing (M-H), General Commercial (C-G) and Suburban Residential (S-R) under resolution 34529 adopted on December 11, 1967, and

WHEREAS, Spencer Industries, Inc. site located in section 32 township 24 range 4 is bordered on two of its three sides by property currently zoned General Commercial, and

WHEREAS, Spencer Aircraft, Division of Spencer Industries was established in 1945, and

WHEREAS, Spencer Industries is interested in having the company's adjoining properties under one zone, and

WHEREAS, area zoning in this portion of unincorporated King County has not been updated in the past 26 years and is not scheduled to be updated in the near future, and

WHEREAS, King County's policy is to work cooperatively with the private sector to encourage economic development which will provide continuing employment and economic vitality, and

WHEREAS, development and redevelopment within this urban portion of the county has become an issue of current concern to the county, and
