2 A MOTION authorizing the executive to submit grant
3 applications to the Washington State Department of
4 Ecology to fund projects to improve water quality in
5 King County.

6 WHEREAS, the Washington State legislature has created the
7 Centennial Clean Water Fund for the joint funding of water quality
8 improvement activities and facilities with other public agencies in the
9 state pursuant to Chapter 70.146 RCW, and

10 WHEREAS, the Washington State legislature has required the
11 development of the 1987, 1989 and 1991 Puget Sound Water Quality
12 Management Plans that require local governments to conduct certain
13 planning and implementation activities related to preserving or
14 improving water quality in Puget Sound and in waters tributary to Puget
15 Sound, and

16 WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology has invited
17 eligible project sponsors to submit proposals for Centennial Clean Water
18 Fund grants for fiscal year 1995, and

19 WHEREAS, approximately \$31,400,000 in total funds will be
20 available for a variety of water pollution control facilities and
21 activities, and

22 WHEREAS, the state grant share generally will be 50 to 75 percent
23 of the total eligible cost of a project, and

24 WHEREAS, eligible projects include: water pollution control
25 facilities and activities and comprehensive planning projects, and

26 WHEREAS, applications will be accepted by the Washington State
27 Department of Ecology until February 25, 1994, and

28 WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology will formally
29 offer financial assistance to the highest priority ranked proposals in
30 May 1994, and

31 WHEREAS, a single government entity may receive financial
32 assistance for a total of five projects, two of which may be water
pollution control facilities projects, and

1 WHEREAS, each water pollution control facility project may receive
2 up to \$2,500,000 in financial assistance, and each water pollution
3 control activity may receive up to \$250,000 in financial assistance;

4 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the King County Council:

5 A. The county executive is hereby authorized to develop and
6 submit to the Washington State Department of Ecology proposals for water
7 quality activities and facilities as described in Attachment A.

8 B. The county executive is hereby authorized to negotiate, to
9 enter into and execute such agreements or contracts as are required by
10 the Washington State Department of Ecology in order to accept grant
11 funding for King County's proposals identified by the department as
12 eligible for financial assistance in fiscal year 1995.

13 C. Final execution and signing of agreements or contracts related
14 to the acceptance of grant funding is contingent on approval of matching
15 funds through the regular county budget process.

16 D. Council authorization of grant application does not constitute
17 a commitment to provide county funding at levels projected in the
18 applications.
