A MOTION authorizing the county executive to apply for Stanley Foundation funds in the approximate amount of \$360,000 for medical examiner division to participate in research of schizophrenia and bipolar disorders.

WHEREAS, the medical examiner division of the Seattle-King County department of public health is responsible for investigating sudden, unexpected and violent deaths, including the performance of postmortem examinations, and

WHEREAS, mental disorders are potential factors which influence intentional and unintentional deaths, and

WHEREAS, King County considers it important to develop a better understanding of the possible causes of mental disorders, and

WHEREAS, the Stanley Foundation awards funds to local governments to participate in research in the study of schizophrenia, bipolar disorders and other mental disorders, and

WHEREAS, the Stanley Foundation contemplates awarding funds to King County in 1994, 1995 and 1996;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to apply to the Stanley Foundation for approximately \$360,000 to participate in research on schizophrenia and bipolar disorders.

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
