## MOTION NO. 9257

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to apply for 1994 "Healthy Families--King County" funds in the approximate amount of \$75,000 from the Boeing Employees Good Neighbor Fund to support home visitation services at two pilot sites for the purpose of protecting and promoting the health of children and families.

WHEREAS, the period immediately following birth is crucial to the development of a healthy baby and a healthy parenting relationship, and the Seattle-King County department of public health recognizes that every family should have access to a home visit when a baby is born, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County department of public health provides public health nurse home visits to families with newborns, usually prioritized to at-risk families due to the high volume of referrals, and

WHEREAS, home visitation programs, such as Hawaii's "Healthy Start" program, have demonstrated their effectiveness in promoting healthy child development and reducing the incidence of child abuse and neglect, and

WHEREAS, under the sponsorship of the Human Services Roundtable, an extensive collaborative effort involving many agencies has modified the "Healthy Start" model into "Healthy Families--King County" that builds upon existing resources and community strengths, and

WHEREAS, the "Healthy Families--King County" project, with support from the King County Children and Families Commission, will commence in 1994 at two pilot sites in Auburn and Southeast Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the Boeing Employees Good Neighbor Fund is interested in granting funds to support the start-up costs of community-based, comprehensive, and coordinated activities that promote the health of children and families;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$75,000 to the Boeing Employees Good Neighbor Fund, for a project to support a home visitation program designed to prevent child abuse and neglect and promote healthy parenting and child development.

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
