A MOTION authorizing the Executive to enter into an agreement with the Vashon Island School District 402 for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a sewer transmission main system in Council District 8.

WHEREAS, the Vashon Island School District 402 has filed an application for a franchise in council district 8 to construct, operate and maintain sewer tightline transmission system to serve the Vashon Island School District campus at Vashon Center in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements are incorporated in the Vashon Sewer District's comprehensive plan which was approved on February 3, 1993, by King County council ordinance 10729, and

WHEREAS, due to septic system failures at the school district campus at Vashon Center, the King County health department, in its January, 1991 Vashon Island Sanitary Survey Comprehensive Report, identified this area as a health caution area, and

WHEREAS, the sewer tightline transmission mainline is to be used solely for the purpose of transporting sewage from the Vashon Island School District campus at Vashon Center to the Vashon Island Sewer District system for treatment and disposal, and

WHEREAS, this sewer transmission mainline (tightline) will not be available for any other connections, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the relevant county departments for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has recommended approval of the franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of Metropolitan King County:
