A MOTION authorizing the county executive to execute a contract for emergency management assistance services.

WHEREAS, King County, State of Washington, discharges its responsibility to furnish emergency management assistance to its citizens by its office of emergency management, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Development is an agency of the State of Washington and administers and allocates Federal funds to reimburse counties for the performance of certain emergency management assistant tasks, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Development has revised it former procedures for providing such reimbursements to require the execution of contract documents as the vehicle therefor, and

WHEREAS, the execution of such contract documents requires the use of procedures under the Interlocal Cooperative Act, RCW Chapter 39.34;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute a contract, substantially in the form attached (Contract Number 1-94-622-11) with the State of Washington, Department of Community Development, for the reimbursement to King County of certain emergency management assistance services.
