MOTION NO. 9273

A MOTION requesting the Boundary Review Board to review pursuant to RCW 36.93.100 the proposed incorporation of Vashon Island

WHEREAS, the Boundary Review Board (BRB) was created to provide a neutral forum for the public hearing and the review and determination of proposed annexations and incorporations to avoid competition to extend municipal boundaries, to prevent haphazard boundary extensions and to create and preserve logical service areas, as set forth as purposes and objectives of the BRB in RCW 36.93.180, and

WHEREAS, coordination between jurisdictions and examination of service issues should be encouraged, and

WHEREAS, citizens of Vashon Island have filed a notice of intention to incorporate an area known as "Vashon Island" as a city, and

WHEREAS, a fiscal feasibility study has been requested under the auspices of the BRB as an independent agent, and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.93.100 provides for the BRB to review proposed incorporations and King County Ordinance No. 8389 provides for a means of requesting such review, and

WHEREAS, the public is best served by open public hearing and review of these issues;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Washington State Boundary Review Board for King County is requested to review the proposed incorporation of the "City of Vashon Island", BRB File No. 1861
