A MOTION authorizing the county Executive to execute contracts with the cities of Black Diamond, Carnation and Duvall for continuation of communication law enforcement services.

WHEREAS, King County has traditionally been willing to assist cities within its jurisdiction when called upon to do so, and

WHEREAS, King County has, for years past, contracted with certain cities within its jurisdiction for communication law enforcement service, and

King County is desirous of continuing such service under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, RCW Chapter 39.34;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to execute contracts, in substantially the form attached, with the cities of Black Diamond, Carnation and Duvall for continuation of communication law enforcement services. Said contracts to be effective for a period of three years, beginning January 1, 1994.
