WHEREAS, in 1991 the former Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle initiated a U-Pass Program with the University of Washington to address traffic congestion and concerns by the City of Seattle and the University District community regarding the university's plans for future growth and development, and

WHEREAS, the initial agreement for public transportation services (U-Pass agreement) between the University of Washington and the Municipality (now King County department of metropolitan services) will expire in September, 1994, and

WHEREAS, under the current U-Pass agreement annual transit trips have increased by 2.6 million, the number of vanpools have increased by 200 percent and the vehicle trips to the University of Washington have been reduced by 17 percent, and

WHEREAS, the continuation of the U-Pass Program for an additional three years will allow King County to build on the successes of the current program and the University of Washington to meet the City of Seattle's mitigation requirements for its Physical Development Plan,
