2 A MOTION authorizing the county executive
3 to enter into an agreement with the
4 University of Washington for public
5 transportation services.

6 WHEREAS, in 1991 the former Municipality of Metropolitan
7 Seattle initiated a U-Pass Program with the University of
8 Washington to address traffic congestion and concerns by the
9 city of Seattle and the University District community regarding
10 the university's plans for future growth and development, and

11 WHEREAS, the initial agreement for public transportation
12 services (U-Pass agreement) between the University of
13 Washington and the Municipality (now King County department of
14 metropolitan services) will expire in September, 1994, and

15 WHEREAS, under the current U-Pass agreement annual transit
16 trips have increased by 2.6 million, the number of vanpools
17 have increased by 200 percent and the vehicle trips to the
18 University of Washington have been reduced by 17 percent, and

19 WHEREAS, the continuation of the U-Pass Program for an
20 additional three years will allow King County to build on the
21 successes of the current program and the University of
22 Washington to meet the City of Seattle's mitigation
23 requirements for its Physical Development Plan,

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
25 The county executive is authorized to execute and administer an

1 agreement for public transportation services with the
2 University of Washington, substantially in the form of Exhibit
3 A attached hereto.

4 PASSED this 9th day of May, 1994.
