A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant preapplication and application for funds in the approximate amount of \$636,300 and to enter into and execute contracts pursuant to the granting of such funds to support the reconstruction of the southeast taxiway, the overlay of the east aprons and the replacement of the airfield lighting generator at the King County International Airport/Boeing Field.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, is empowered to make grants to support improvements at public airports, and

WHEREAS, reconstruction of the southeast taxiway will increase the pavement strength and will extend its useful service life, and

WHEREAS, the placing of the asphalt overlay to portions of the east aircraft aprons will increase the pavement strength and extend its useful service life, and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the generator will provide the needed standby power for the airfield lighting system, and

WHEREAS, these projects will assist the county in meeting the operational needs of the users of the King County International Airport/Boeing Field;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make preapplication and application for funds in the approximate amount of \$636,300 to the Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, to support the reconstruction of the southeast taxiway, the overlay of the east aprons and the replacement of the airfield lighting generator at the King County International Airport/Boeing Field, on behalf of King County;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
