2 A MOTION Relating to King County's
3 official newspaper, approving the
4 selection of a newspaper pursuant to RCW
5 36.72.075, and vesting authority in the
6 chair of the King County council to
7 approve future selections by the
8 Executive of an official County
9 newspaper.

10 WHEREAS, the business conducted and legislation to be
11 enacted need to be made known to the public, and

12 WHEREAS, the mechanism for doing so is through the
13 advertising for legally prescribed periods of time of
14 proposed ordinances scheduled to come before the King County
15 council for adoption, and

16 WHEREAS, RCW 36.72.075 prescribes the process and the
17 criteria to be used in the selection of an official county
18 newspaper to be used to advertise pending legislation, and

19 WHEREAS, RCW 36.72.075 requires that the newspaper
20 selected as the official county newspaper be approved by the
21 county's legislative authority, and

22 WHEREAS, RCW 36.72.075 allows for the legislative
23 authority to delegate the approval of the executive's
24 recommended selection for the official county newspaper to
25 the council chair;

26 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
27 County:

28 A. The King County council approves the selection of
29 the Seattle Times to be the official King County newspaper
30 for the period 1994 through 1995.
