MOTION NO. <u>9368</u>

A MOTION requesting that the Puget Sound Regional Council include Paine Field in its Major Supplemental Airport Feasibility Study.

WHEREAS, in its Resolution A-93-03, the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) general assembly indicated that a major supplemental airport (MSA) should be located within the PSRC four county area, and

WHEREAS, the PSRC executive board, on August 26, 1993 and September 23, 1993, agreed upon certain implementation steps to study the siting and location of an MSA, and

WHEREAS, the PSRC has retained consultants and established the process to study the location and feasibility of an MSA, and

WHEREAS, the MSA working group has made recommendations to the PSRC regarding six possible study sites, and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 1994, the PSRC Growth

Management and Transportation Policy Boards have recommended

to the PSRC Executive Board that the Arlington, Marysville

East, and Tanwax Lake sites be carried forward for further

study, and

WHEREAS, the PSRC Executive Board will be reviewing these recommendations to determine which sites shall be examined in the more detailed Phase 2 section of the MSA Feasibility Study, and

WHEREAS, significant time may pass until construction of an MSA, and

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WHEREAS, Paine Field may be able to accommodate commercial commuter operations on a limited interim basis only, and

WHEREAS, the Phase 2 MSA Feasibility Study will need to examine timing for construction of an MSA and necessary interim air capacity options until an MSA is operational, and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the PSRC to study all reasonable options, and

WHEREAS, PSRC Resolution A-93-03 limits Paine Field as a preferred alternative and an MSA, but does not preclude studying Paine Field for interim commuter purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

It shall be the policy of the King County council to encourage and request the Executive Board to:

- 1. Endorse and support the recommendations of the Growth Management and Transportation Policy Boards of the PSRC regarding those sites recommended for study in Phase 2 of the Major Supplemental Airport (MSA) Site study.
- 2. Include in Phase 2 study of possible uses of Paine Field for limited interim commercial commuter services.
- 3. Should the PSRC find no feasible MSA sites within the four county region, the PSRC is encouraged and requested to extend the current study to include the following alternatives:

1	a. A major supplemental airport site outside of the PSRC
2	four county region; and
3	b. Small supplemental airport sites, including Paine
4	Field, within the PSRC four county region.
