



1           2. Meeting prior to GMPC meetings in an attempt to  
2 develop a county concensus on issues,

3           3. Working together on procedural and  
4 jurisdictional issues, and

5           4. Regularly attending GMPC meetings. Members  
6 shall give at least one week's advance notice to the  
7 council's spokesperson to provide notice to alternates. The  
8 council's spokesperson may excuse a member from this notice  
9 and attendance requirements on less than one week's notice if  
10 good cause is shown and alternates are able to attend.

11           E. These appointments shall expire on January 31, 1996.

12           F. The chair of the GMPC is requested to convene a  
13 working group of GMPC members to discuss mechanisms for  
14 improving representation of unincorporated and rural areas.  
15 The county council should consider improving representation  
16 of unincorporated and rural areas when establishing  
17 membership in 1996.
