2 A MOTION relating to the creation of a
3 King County Bicycle Advisory Committee to
4 advise the King County Council in 1995 on
5 matters relating to mountain bicycling
6 and other bicycling opportunities.

7 WHEREAS, the King County council adopted Motion 9369
8 approving the master plan for Cougar Mountain Regional
9 Wildland Park on September 12, 1994, and

10 WHEREAS, at the time of the adoption of the Cougar
11 Mountain Regional Wildland Park Master Plan, the King County
12 council committed to working with bicycling organizations and
13 individuals to help facilitate mountain bicycle opportunities
14 in King County, and

15 WHEREAS, councilmembers requested that a bicycling
16 advisory committee be developed to advise the council on
17 issues relating to mountain bicycle opportunities and to also
18 review and advise on other bicycling policy issues;

19 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
20 County:

21 There is hereby created a King County Bicycle Advisory
22 Committee whose membership shall be comprised as follows:

23 Two representatives each from the Backcountry Bicycle
24 Trails Club, the Cascade Bicycle Club, the Northwest Bicycle
25 Federation, and the King County Nonmotorized Transportation
26 Advisory Committee; and

1 Two individual bicyclists from King County who are not
2 affiliated with or representing the above listed
3 organizations; and

4 One representative each from King County public works
5 roads and engineering division, King County parks division,
6 and King County council program staff.

7 Provided further that the King County Bicycle Advisory
8 Committee shall advise the King County council during 1995 on
9 the following issues:

10 Opportunities for the development of new mountain
11 bicycle facilities and the expansion of existing facilities
12 in King county on public or private lands, and

13 Status of negotiations with private land developers
14 under the county's 4:1 program relating to the use of set-
15 aside open space for off-road bicycling opportunities, and

16 Policies in the proposed King County Park, Recreation
17 and Open Space Plan relating to bicycling activities and
18 facilities, and

19 Policies related to transportation issues such as
20 bicycle lanes on street right-of-ways, racks on buses and at
21 bus stops, and on-road bicycling safety issues, provided that
22 recommendations on transportation issues be coordinated with
23 the King County Nonmotorized Transportation Advisory
24 Committee.

1 Provided further that, the King County Bicycle Advisory
2 Committee shall make a recommendation to the council no later
3 than December 31, 1995 regarding the structure of a permanent
4 advisory committee to advise the county beyond 1995 on
5 mountain bicycle issues in addition to on-road bicycling
6 issues. This recommendation may include restructuring the
7 existing King County Nonmotorized Transportation Advisory
8 Committee to add additional citizen members representing off-
9 road bicycling interests and additional staff from King
10 County programs that deal with recreational bicycle issues.
