A MOTION establishing a steering committee of county elected officials to guide the negotiation of a contract with the University of Washington for the management and operation of Harborview Medical Center.

WHEREAS, Harborview Medical Center is a county-owned 8 facility that is managed and operated by the University of 9 Washington under the terms and conditions of a management 10 contract between the Harborview Board of Trustees and the 11 University, and 12

WHEREAS, the management contract has been in effect 13 since February 1, 1984 and is due to expire on June 30, 1995, 14 15 and

WHEREAS, Harborview Medical Center is nationally 16 recognized as a trauma and burn treatment center and as a 17 teaching and research facility, and 18

WHEREAS, Harborview Medical Center is a critical 19 component of a county-wide network of health care providers 20 serving low-income and indigent persons and serves a number 21 of special populations, including the mentally ill, substance 22 abusers and county jail inmates, and 23

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of King County and its residents to continue the contractual relationship with 25 the University to manage and operate Harborview Medical 26 27 Center, and

WHEREAS, a negotiating team consisting of representatives of the Board, the University, the county council and the county executive have been meeting to identify contract issues and develop a new contract which addresses those issues, and
