Involuntary Commitment Cases

Should the Highline Evaluation and Treatment facility move to the proposed West Seattle location, the County will provide additional funds to the Agency based on a change in the average ITA caseload standard per attorney from 425 to 410. This change will take effect the day ITA clients are moved to the new, West Seattle facility. The County will reimburse the Agency at the standard County rate for mileage between the Agency's Seattle office and the new facility, up to twelve (12) miles per trip, not to exceed a maximum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).
