2 A MOTION supporting a proposal to work  
3 with the Northshore Youth Soccer  
4 Association to secure additional athletic  
5 fields in northeast King County to meet  
6 the growing regional demand for  
7 recreational facilities for youth.  
8

9 WHEREAS, The Northshore Youth Soccer Association and the  
10 Little League provide positive role models and recreation  
11 opportunities for more than 5000 youths in King County, and

12 WHEREAS, the lack of available land for athletic fields  
13 forces program restrictions and in some cases results in  
14 families that are turned away from participation, and

15 WHEREAS, the 1993 adopted Northshore Community Plan  
16 identified a deficit in lighted athletic fields and play  
17 areas in the Northshore planning area, relative to its  
18 existing population and relative to other planning areas in  
19 King County, and

20 WHEREAS, the 1993 adopted Northshore Community Plan  
21 stated the need for an additional 395 to 542 acres of  
22 traditional park land to serve projected populations in the  
23 area, and

24 WHEREAS, there are currently no conveniently located  
25 community gardening projects available for Northshore  
26 residents.

27 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King  
28 County: The Metropolitan King County Council endorses the

1 proposal for acquisition and joint development along with the  
 2 Northshore Youth Soccer Association of land south of  
 3 Woodinville's "South By-pass" for active recreation and  
 4 community gardening purposes, provided that the proposal is  
 5 consistent with adopted countywide and comprehensive plan  
 6 policies and complies with zoning code requirements, and  
 7 provide further, the Council requests that the Executive  
 8 transmit an ordinance which establishes the "Northshore  
 9 Soccer Fields and Community Gardens Project" as a King County  
 10 park acquisition and development project and appropriates  
 11 adequate funds to administer the project.

12 PASSED by a vote of 13 to 0 this 5<sup>th</sup> day of  
 13 June, 1995.
