A MOTION authorizing the executive to execute an amendment to an interlocal agreement between King County and the city of Newcastle for the provision of law enforcement services.

WHEREAS, King County and the cities that contract with the county for law enforcement services have been working together for nearly a year to develop a new contract model for delivering and pricing law enforcement services, and

WHEREAS, this work is now complete and the result is a new contract model which offers cities options for service delivery and provides cities with greater control over service levels and costs, and

WHEREAS, the police contract cities, including the city of Newcastle, are in the process of reviewing a proposal from the county based on the new model for the purpose of making decisions about whether to continue to contract with the county and, if so, about service levels beginning January 1, 1996, and

WHEREAS, the city of Newcastle is also reviewing a proposal for law enforcement services from the city of Renton, and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the existing interlocal agreement between King County and Newcastle, the city is required to provide the county with at least six months written notice of its intent to terminate the agreement, and

1           WHEREAS, if the city selects Renton as its service  
2 provider with the intention of Renton initiating service on  
3 January 1, 1996, the city must provide the county such  
4 written notice by June 30, 1995, and

5           WHEREAS, June 30 is only four days from the date of the  
6 introduction of this motion, and

7           WHEREAS, King County has not had an opportunity to  
8 review Renton's proposal and develop an alternate county  
9 proposal for consideration by the city, and

10          WHEREAS, if the city is interested in having more time  
11 to review an alternate proposal from the county, the existing  
12 interlocal agreement could be amended to shorten the six-  
13 month written notice requirement, and

14          WHEREAS, although it is not known if the city desires  
15 additional time to review an alternate county proposal, the  
16 county council would like to leave this option open by  
17 passing this motion providing the executive with the  
18 necessary authority to execute an amendment to the existing  
19 interlocal agreement to shorten the six-month written notice  
20 requirement;

21          NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King  
22 County:

23          The county executive is hereby authorized to execute an  
24 amendment, substantially in the form attached, to the  
25 interlocal agreement between King County and the city of

1 Newcastle for the provision of law enforcement services for  
2 the purpose of shortening the six-months written notice  
3 requirement to a time period mutually agreed upon by the  
4 county and the city.

6 June, 1995.
