MOTION NO. **9614**

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A MOTION endorsing the King County Parks Division's 1996 Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation project funding applications.

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WHEREAS, the population in King County is estimated to increase by 325,000 in the next 15 years, and

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WHEREAS, King County general revenues for acquisition and development of parks and open space are stagnant or declining due to a number of factors including annexations and incorporations, and

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WHEREAS, the Washington Wildlife Recreation Program Account, administered through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation (IAC) has provided over \$9 million to King County since 1990 for acquisition and development of critical open space, parks and trails throughout King County including the Missing Link, Cottage Lake Park, Three Forks Park, Cedar River Trail, Salmon Creek, and Lisabeula, and

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WHEREAS, King County is seeking 1996 development funding for Cedar River Trail Paving, Beaver Lake Ballfield, Big Finn Hill Ballfields, and acquisition funding for the Green River Waterway, Cottage Lake Creek Headwaters, and the Maplewood Expansion, and

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WHEREAS, the King County IAC funding applications are for regional services that benefits all King County residents;

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NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King  
County:

The Metropolitan King County Council endorses the 1996 King  
County Parks Division IAC funding applications.
