3 County board of ethics' proposal for
4 hosting the 1997 Council on Governmental
5 Ethics Laws Conference.

7 WHEREAS, the King County board of ethics has assisted
8 county government in implementing the Code of Ethics to
9 assure the public of the impartiality and honesty of county
10 officials and employees in public decisions, and

11 WHEREAS, these efforts promote public confidence in
12 government and result in direct benefits to the citizens of
13 King County, and

14 WHEREAS, the King County board of ethics has proposed to
15 host the 1997 Council on Governmental Ethics Laws Conference
16 to further international understanding of issues relating to
17 ethics in government and to enhance the King County ethics
18 program, and

19 WHEREAS, the King County board of ethics is one of two
20 finalists and will make a presentation to the members of the
21 Council of Governmental Ethics Laws to host its conference in
22 1997;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
24 County:

25 A. King County government is hereby committed to the
26 role of ethics in government and believes that this role can
27 be enhanced through cooperation and exchange with other
28 governmental agencies.

1 B. The Metropolitan King County council hereby
2 endorses and fully supports the King County board of ethics'
3 proposal to host the 1997 Council on Governmental Ethics Law
4 Conference.
