MOTION NO. **9744 1**

A MOTION appointing eleven members to the  
Seahawks/Kingdome Renovation Task Force.

WHEREAS, on November 13, 1995, the King County Council  
passed Motion 9707 establishing the Seahawks/Kingdome  
Renovation Task Force, and

WHEREAS, the role of the Seahawks/Kingdome Renovation  
Task Force is to advise the Metropolitan King County Council  
and the King County Executive in matters concerning the  
renovation of the Kingdome, and

WHEREAS, the Seahawks/Kingdome Renovation Task Force is  
to prepare a report to the Council by no later than March 31,  
1996, which, in part, identifies the capital improvements to  
the Kingdome or other facilities or sites that would enhance  
the revenue generating capabilities of King County and its  
tenants and identifies financing options to fund the public  
sector's portion of Kingdome capital improvements, and

WHEREAS, Motion 9707 created the Kingdome Renovation  
Task Force as a 21 member body consisting of eleven  
appointments from the Metropolitan King County Council and  
ten appointments from the King County Executive, and

WHEREAS, Motion 9707 states that the Chair and Vice  
Chair of the Budget and Fiscal Management Committee shall  
recommend to the full council the eleven members that will  
represent the appointments of the King County Council, and

1           WHEREAS, Motion 9707 states that the eleven  
2 appointments from the Council shall include a  
3 representative of the International District community,  
4 the trade show industry, and an individual with  
5 expertise in stadium construction financing; and

6           WHEREAS, the executive's ten appointments shall  
7 include a representative of the Seattle Seahawks, the  
8 Pioneer Square community, and an individual with  
9 expertise in stadium construction; and

10           WHEREAS, Motion 9707 states that the task force  
11 shall be chaired by two individuals. One co-chair shall  
12 be appointed by the council and one co-chair shall be  
13 appointed by the executive. The chair and vice chair of  
14 the council's Budget and Fiscal Management Committee  
15 shall be ex officio members of the task force.
