
A MOTION confirming the Executive's appointment of Hal Bergem, who resides in Council District Two, to the King County Fair Board.

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The county executive's appointment of Hal Bergem, who resides in Council District Two, to the King County Fair Board, term to expire on September 30, 1998, is hereby confirmed.
