2 A MOTION recognizing the importance of
3 the work of the Kingdome Renovation Task
4 Force and reaffirming the continuing role
5 of the Task Force in matters concerning
6 the renovation of the Kingdome.

8 WHEREAS, on November 13, 1995, the Metropolitan King
9 County Council passed Motion 9707 creating the Kingdome
10 renovation task force; and

11 WHEREAS, Motion 9707 recognizes the important economic
12 benefit the Kingdome and its tenants provide to this region;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, Motion 9707 also recognizes that the Kingdome
15 and its tenants generate significant tax revenues for the
16 State of Washington, the City of Seattle, and to a lessor
17 degree, King County; and

18 WHEREAS, the mission of the task force is to prepare a
19 report which, in part, identifies the capital improvements to
20 the Kingdome that would enhance the revenue generating
21 capabilities of the Kingdome and its tenants and offers
22 funding options; and

23 WHEREAS, the King County Executive and the King County
24 Council have appointed a 21 member task force made up of
25 prominent government, business and community leaders; and

1 WHEREAS, the Kingdome Renovation Task force has begun to
2 meet to address Kingdome renovation issues; and

3 WHEREAS, the work of the Kingdome Task Force continues
4 to be vital in evaluating ways to enhance the Kingdome for
5 all of its current and future tenants and the public.

6 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
7 County: The King County Council re-affirms its commitment to
8 the important work of the Kingdome Renovation Task Force to
9 advise the County on how the Kingdome may be enhanced. The
10 Council recognizes the expertise of the esteemed members of
11 the Kingdome renovation task force, and urges them to
12 continue their valuable work.
