2 A MOTION authorizing free disposal of flood-
3 related debris resulting from the flood of
4 February 8, 1996.

5 WHEREAS, King County experienced unusually destructive
6 flooding beginning February 8, 1996, causing significant damage
7 to homes and other property, and

8 WHEREAS, the executive, on February 8, 1996 declared a flood
9 emergency for King County, and

10 WHEREAS, disposal of waste material resulting from the
11 flooding at normal disposal fees would cause financial hardship
12 for many property owners, and

13 WHEREAS, all of King County will benefit from the cleanup of
14 damage caused by the flooding, and

15 WHEREAS, the executive, on February 9, 1996, called for
16 waived fees for the disposal of flood-related debris at County
17 disposal sites beginning February 10, 1996, and

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to K.C.C. 10.12.050B, actions taken by the
19 executive to waive fees that continue beyond the date of the next
20 regularly scheduled council meeting require council approval by
21 motion for continuation;

22 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 A. The King County council hereby authorizes the executive
24 to eliminate solid waste disposal fees for noncommercial haulers
25 for flood-related debris related to damage from the flood of
26 February 8, 1996.

27 B. These actions are authorized only through February 25,
28 1996. The executive shall report to the utilities and natural

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1 resources committee in the event there is a need to continue the
2 disposal fee waiver.

4 February, 1996.
