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
A MOTION confirming the Executive's reappointment of Nancy B. McKenney to the King County Animal Control Citizen's Advisory Committee.

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:



A Brief Biography on Nancy Buckingham McKenney

Executive Director of The Humane Society & SPCA of Seattle/King County, 1986 -

The Humane Society & SPCA is a non-profit, private organization dedicated to the prevention of cruelty to animals. As Executive Director, Nancy is responsible for the overall management of the agency and for carrying out the agency's mission and policies as guided by the Board of Directors. She administers programs, services and long range plan and is accountable for supervising 36 paid staff and over 400 unpaid staff (volunteers) at The Humane Society.

Nancy first started in 1983 as The Humane Society's Public Relations Coordinator until 1985. In 1986, she was elected to the Board of Directors prior to being hired as Executive Director.

President of the Washington Federation of Animal Care and Control Agencies, 1992 -

This state-wide organization addresses training, legislative and educational issues for animals and the professionals who work in animal care and control agencies.

Nancy served on the Federation's Board of Directors several years before being elected President in May, 1992.

Member of the King County Animal Control Citizens Advisory Committee, 1992 -

This 11 member advisory committee is a mechanism for King County citizens and consumers of animal control services to provide information and advice about animal control needs, goals and services to the King County executive, council and animal control section.

Chair of the King County Spay/Neuter Coalition, 1991 - 1992.

This diverse group was formed to address the proposed animal breeding regulations introduced by King County Councilmember Ron Sims. The Coalition met regularly (logging in well over 1,000 hours), held two public hearings and presented a detailed report, on time, to the council in July, 1992. The King County Council listened to the Coalition and passed an ordinance that is more conducive to improving the services and effectiveness of animal control.

Member of the Alumnae Board at Forest Ridge School, 1992 -94.

Selected as the local representative for the Associated Alumnae of the Sacred Heart. Assisting with plans for the first alumnae "homecoming" weekend event in May, 1993, in addition to the responsibilities of being on the board.

Member of the Society of Animal Welfare Administrators (SAWA), 1987 -

This national organization promotes humane ideals through a professional approach to management of private or governmental animal welfare/control agencies.

Development Assistant and Journalism Advisor at Forest Ridge School in Bellevue, 1985 - 1986.

Assisted with various fund raising and public relations activities. Also advised the student journalism class which produced a school newspaper.

Awards

Honored as the "Humanitarian of the Year" by the Washington Federation of Animal Care and Control Agencies, 1992.

Honored as "Director of the Year" by Humane Society employees, 1988.

Honored as one of the "Local Heroes" by the Seattle Weekly Readers, 1987.

B.A. in History from Brown University in Providence, Rhode Island. Also studied at American University in Washington, D.C.

Personal

Born in Seattle, resident of Bellevue for over 20 years.

Member of the Entomological Society of the Pacific Northwest, Greater Seattle Chapter.
