A MOTION expressing the intent of the Metropolitan King County Council to conduct a "zero-based" budget review of the transit department program in 1996.

WHEREAS, the transit department has a total annual operating budget of nearly \$265 million per year, and a 1996 capital improvement budget of an additional \$175 million, and

WHEREAS, the regional transit committee, the executive and the county council have jointly developed a comprehensive plan to substantially increase bus service throughout the transit service area over the next six years, and

WHEREAS, county executive recommended approval of a 10 percent transit fare increase effective September 1996 in the 1996 executive proposed budget to generate revenues to support planned system expansion and enhancements, and

WHEREAS, the council has developed a comprehensive work plan to review the transit budget and explore cost-saving opportunities to fund service expansion by examining financial information such as: historical spending, historical revenues, audit findings over the past ten years, an assessment of capital program, review of performance indicators, identification of prioritized cost centers, comparative analysis of King County transit with other
