WHEREAS, regional economic development efforts will be improved through greater understanding of how activity in the Kent Manufacturing Industrial Center is linked to the

WHEREAS, the King County Comprehensive Plan requires

King County government to cooperate with local jurisdictions

to develop regional strategies to support and attract

industrial employers who provide family-wage jobs;
