WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for annual general elections held in King County, and

WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.090 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 12301 provides for submission to the voters on November 5, 1996 a proposition to amend the King county charter to create the elective office of county sheriff, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 12191 provides for submission to the voters on November 5, 1996 a proposition to amend the King County Charter to provide for redistricting once every ten years rather than once every five years;
