4 Recreation and Conservation Legacy
5 Program Bond and Maintenance Levy for the
6 September 17, 1996 primary election.

8 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the
9 publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in
10 conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for even
11 numbered year primaries when the county has a measure on the
12 ballot, and

13 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.090 provides that for each measure
14 from a jurisdiction that is included in a local voters
15 pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction
16 shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments
17 advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to
18 prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,
19 and

20 WHEREAS, Ordinance 12392 provides for submission to the
21 voters on September 17, 1996 a capital bond proposition to
22 adopt funding of county-wide recreation and conservation
23 programs for the Recreation and Conservation Legacy Program,
24 and

25 WHEREAS, Ordinance 12393 provides for submission to the
26 voters on September 17, 1996 a maintenance levy proposition
27 to adopt funding for maintenance and stewardship for the
28 projects of the Recreation and Conservation Legacy Program;

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
31 County:

1 The following individuals are appointed to serve on the
2 voter pamphlet committees to write statements relating to the
3 proposed propositions for funding of county-wide recreation
4 and conservation projects for the Recreation and Conservation
5 Legacy Program and for funding of maintenance and stewardship
6 for those projects.
