A MOTION appointing committees to write voters pamphlet statements for a special election on November 5, 1996 for the incorporation as a non-charter code city the area commonly known as Covington.

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10 as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for special elections, and

WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides for each measure from a local jurisdiction that is included in a local voters' pamphlet that the legislative authority for the jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval of the measure and shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 also provides that the legislative authority shall appoint persons known to favor the measure to serve on the committee advocating approval and shall whenever possible, appoint persons known to oppose the measure to serve on the committee advocating rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, each committee shall not have more than three members but may seek the advice of any person or persons, and

WHEREAS Ordinance 12457 establishes November 5, 1996 as the date for submission to the voters the question of whether
