2 A MOTION appointing committees to write
3 voters pamphlet statements for a special
4 election on November 5, 1996 for the
5 incorporation as a non-charter code city
6 the area commonly known as Maple Valley.

7 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10 as amended, provides for the
8 publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in
9 conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for
10 special elections, and

11 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides for each measure from a
12 local jurisdiction that is included in a local voters'
13 pamphlet that the legislative authority for the jurisdiction
14 shall appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating
15 voters' approval of the measure and shall formally appoint a
16 committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' rejection
17 of the measure, and

18 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 also provides that the
19 legislative authority shall appoint persons known to favor
20 the measure to serve on the committee advocating approval and
21 shall whenever possible, appoint persons known to oppose the
22 measure to serve on the committee advocating rejection of the
23 measure, and

24 WHEREAS, each committee shall not have more than three
25 members but may seek the advice of any person or persons, and

26 WHEREAS Ordinance 12456 establishes November 5, 1996 as
27 the date for submission to the voters the question of whether

1 the area commonly known as Maple Valley shall be incorporated
2 as a non-charter code city under the council manager form of
3 government;

4 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
5 County:


6 A. The following individuals are appointed to serve on
7 the voter pamphlet committees to write statements relating to
8 the proposed propositions for the incorporation as a non-
9 charter code city the area commonly known as Maple Valley.
