MOTION NO. 9949

A MOTION authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of gifts and donations to the surface water management division or its successor agency.

WHEREAS, the King County surface water management division, or its successor agency, is charged under K.C.C. 9.04 and 9.08 to provide for the comprehensive management of surface and storm water, and under K.C.C. 9.12 to protect King County's surface and ground water quality, and

whereas, the surface water management division or its successor agency will implement programs to provide these services primarily through preventative actions and protection of the natural drainage system as directed by the council in K.C.C. 9.08.040, and

WHEREAS, private funding will enhance the effectiveness of the surface water management division's work by increasing its scope and reach and by educating and involving the public in surface water management and water quality projects;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The surface water management division, and any successor agency, may accept the following gifts and donations on the country's behalf without approval by the council subject to the following conditions:

1. The gifts and donations must be for the sole purpose of enhancing the division's ability to complete its work program.

1	2. The gifts or donations may include cash and non-cash
2	personal property and services, but not real property.
3	Cash gifts greater than \$5000, and non-cash gifts of
4	greater value than \$10,000, shall be subject to council review and
5	approval. The division shall report to the council annually, no
6	later than March 31 of each year, on gifts and services received
7	in the previous year that were under these thresholds.
. 8	4. Gifts and donations shall not be accepted if they are
9	offered by a grantor who is doing business or seeks to do business
10	with the division and the circumstances surrounding the gift or
11	donation suggest to a reasonable and prudent person that the gift
12	or donation is intended to obtain special consideration or
13	influence a division decision affecting the grantor.
14	B Except where council approval is otherwise required
15	herein, the manager of the division is authorized to expend
16	donations and use gifts in accordance within the terms of the
17	grantor without further appropriation from the council. Gifts or
18	donations above the thresholds identified in paragraph A3 above
19	that are made without restriction shall require approval through
20	the normal council appropriation process.
