A MOTION authorizing the disposal by a sealed bid public sale of a 1991 Bell Model 206 L3 helicopter.

WHEREAS, the department of public safety owns a 1991 Bell helicopter known as Guardian One assigned to the air support unit located at King County International Airport, and

WHEREAS, the department of public safety has determined that the helicopter is surplus to its needs for surveillance and search and rescue operations, and

WHEREAS, the sale of the helicopter will generate revenue to eliminate approximately \$ 284,000 in debt service and provide revenue to benefit the county current expense fund, and

WHEREAS, the sale of the helicopter would result in an approximate reduction of \$ 100,000 in insurance costs, and

WHEREAS, the department of public safety has replaced the air support provided by Guardian One with three similar aircraft and additional equipment for replacement parts obtained through the Federal Military Surplus Program at very low cost, and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of King County Ordinance 12045 requires county council approval before disposal of personal property with a value of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars or more,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to conduct a sealed bid public sale of a 1991 Bell Model 206 L3 helicopter.
