3 three portable breath alcohol content instruments from the Boeing  
4 Company to the King County department of public safety to

7 WHEREAS, the King County department of public safety operates a field operation  
8 division responsible for patrolling the roads in King County and enforcing the traffic laws, and

9 WHEREAS, public safety will be enhanced by using portable breath testing instruments  
10 to assess probable cause for arrest of persons suspected of driving while under the influence and  
11 assessing the safety of others to operate a motor vehicle, and

12 WHEREAS, the Boeing Company has three surplus Intoximeters (Portable Breath  
13 Alcohol Content Instruments) it wishes to donate to King County for use by the department of  
14 public safety in traffic enforcement, and

15 WHEREAS, the value of this donation is three thousand six hundred dollars ( twelve  
16 hundred for each Intoximeter) and enhanced public safety;


17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
